### SOAR'S Impact for April

#### Food & More Program

- 70 seniors on a bi-monthly basis
- 48 volunteer shoppers
- 38 seniors received weekly produce
- 29 seniors received monthly food supplements

#### **Transportation Program**

- 120 transports were provided to 64 seniors Medical Equipment Center
  - 13 pieces of equipment were donated
  - 9 pieces of equipment distributed

#### **Emergency Assistance**

• 14 seniors assisted

## Senior success story

Frances, an 84 year old senior who does not drive recently relocated to Frederick. She was in need of assistance with purchasing groceries and having them delivered. We enrolled her in our bi-monthly grocery program. Her volunteer noticed that she

was in need of a few pieces of furniture for storage and organization. She had nowhere to keep her clothing, laundry or an area to organize her paperwork. With the help of SOAR's resources and our amazing volunteers, she now has room for an extra chair for company, a dresser for her clothing and plenty of storage space for her paperwork and incidentals. She also needed some clothes to be able to attend church and our volunteer was happy to take her shopping and SOAR paid for her new church clothes. She is so happy to have clothes for church, access to transportation and her grocery delivery.



Thank you to Lisa Henley for coordinating this fun day out for our seniors.


