Last month, a 76 year-old senior reached out to SOAR with an urgent need for transportation to her medical appointments. Living on a monthly income of \$980, she was handling a recent cancer diagnosis without family support to help her through it.

Through SOAR's transportation program, she was able to attend all of her cancer treatments that were necessary for her recovery.

With the rigor and intensity of the treatments, she was not able to shop for the groceries she needed. During her recovery, SOAR's Food and More program was a great support. A dedicated volunteer shopped for her groceries and delivered them to her home, ensuring that she had the nutrition needed during this difficult time.
